



# Rat catch numbers seem to be trending down since 2018


#### Rat spp. catch at Travis Wetland 2012-2023




Hedgehogs were mostly caught in the dryer areas with the majority being caught in the dune to the north and east

sides.




1 stoat and one 1 weasel were caught for the season, a stoat was also seen on camera near Frosts rd. prior to one being caught in the peat swamp.




#### Hedgehog and mustelid catch Travis Wetland 2012-2023
